Abstract:

The concept of homotopy and the phenomenon of homotopy invariance plays an important role not only in the study of topological or differentiable manifolds, but also in commutative algebra and algebraic geometry. In the latter, the affine line plays the role of the unit interval. We first review some classical homotopy theory and then discuss several more algebraic results following Quillen, Suslin, Morel-Voevodsky and others.
